

**Software version 1.11 for the AXIS 700 Network Scan Server**

1.11 is an enhancement to the AXIS 700 Network Scan Server embedded software and replaces 1.10. All previously delivered units can be upgraded with the new software, which is available free of charge. All features of the 1.00 and 1.10 software are retained. There is no need to upgrade to 1.11 unless any of the new features/functions are needed.

The main highlights are:

***Support for additional scanners and digital copiers***

Avision:

- AV 820C (600 dpi, 1-pass color and ADF)

Gestetner:

- SC-01 (400 dpi, b/w, A3 and ADF)
- SC-420 (400 dpi, b/w, A3 and optional compression and ADF)
- 3240 (400 dpi digital copier, duplex, requires installed scanning option)

Hewlett Packard:

- ADF for HP 6200/6250, (scanner itself was supported before)

Nashuatec:

- D440 (400 dpi digital copier, duplex, requires installed scanning option)

Rex Rotary:

- 2840 (400 dpi digital copier, duplex, requires installed scanning option)

Ricoh:

- Aficio 401 (400 dpi digital copier, duplex, requires installed scanning option)

### ***Access to e-mail address books enhancements***

The LDAP functionality that was introduced in 1.10 has been improved:

- The destinations retrieved via LDAP/FTP are now only flushed if there is less than 1MB free memory when a scanning starts. In 1.10 all LDAP/FTP destinations were flushed unless more memory was added to the AXIS 700.
- Even if the external destinations are flushed, the currently selected destinations on the control panel remain and are available directly after the scanning.
- LDAP addresses can be used with scan-to-URL and not only for scan-to-e-mail as before.

### ***TIFF enhancements***

Performance is improved with about 5-10%

### ***Web interface***

The new Web pages that were introduced with 1.10 have been updated:

- Loading of the Web pages is much faster.
- Default parameter for URL versus attachment added which means that LDAP destinations now can be used with scan-to-URL.
- Server uptime added on 'This AXIS 700'-page.
- Added possibility to clear the event log.
- Possibility to view all external destinations. This can be used to import LDAP addresses to a text editor to easy make an address list to put on an FTP server when the 'load e-mail addresses from server' function is used.
- The destinations, profiles and paper sizes are now listed when viewing the server settings.
- It is now possible to specify the timeout for SMTP transfers. Previously the connection to the mail server had to be done within 10 seconds which now also is the default value. On networks with heavy load or dial-up connection this time was too short.

### ***Improved Scan-to-URL functionality***

Scan-to-URL produces longer file names e.g. if sent to olof.larsson@... the file name will be olof\_larsson####.ext where the # represents the time stamp. LDAP destinations now can be used with scan-to-URL as a parameter for URL versus attachment has been added.

### ***Fax Server support***

Scan-to-e-mail now handles addresses like these: John Doe <john.doe@axis.com> and john@axis.com (John Doe). This enables support for fax servers like RightFax and FACSys that has an SMTP gateway that can handle attachments as input. A typical fax destination in the AXIS 700 could look like this:

'/name=John Doe/fax=1234567<fax@axis.com>'. For more information about the fax server support please see the technical notes at <http://www.axis.com>.
